	<p>5. Language proficiency certificate (IELTS – 6.0 or higher, TOEFL iBM – 72 score or higher);</p> <p>6. Essay on the topic of <i>“Plans for contribution to the development of tourism and cultural heritage sphere between Uzbekistan and the country of applicant”</i> also outlining future plans upon graduation (Length: 1000 words, double spaced, 12pt).</p> <p>Note: Applicants must upload electronic copies of the above-mentioned documents at the website of the admissions office: http://admissions.univ-silkroad.uz</p>
IV.	<p>Application procedure and period:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Application deadline - 10th of July, 2022; 2. Proctored testing - 20th to 30th of July 2022 (<i>please check your email regularly for the test date details</i>); 3. Interview (<i>online</i>) with prospective applicants - 1st to 10th of August 2022 (<i>please check your email regularly for the interview invitation link</i>); 4. Application decisions announcement – 10th to 20th of August 2022 (<i>regularly check e-mail for results and official website of admission commission</i>); 5. Visa preparation period - from 20th of August 2022; 6. Student enrolment starts from 20th of September 2022.
V.	<p>The grant covers the following expenses:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Return airfare (Economy class) to Uzbekistan. 2. 500 USD (equivalent) monthly stipend and 100 USD (equivalent) for dormitory expenses. 3. 100 USD (equivalent) will be allocated for each trip (twice a year) to Uzbekistan’s ancient cities with the purpose to explore the country’s cultural, architectural riches and become acquainted with its’ diverse traditions and history.
