# RUSSIAN GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP 2026/2027 Apply until 15 January, 2026

## WHAT DOES THE SCHOLARSHIP COVER?

Russian Government Scholarship is a full tuition fee scholarship. For the 2026/2027 intake it may cover <u>Undergraduate</u>, <u>Postgraduate</u> and <u>Residency studies</u>, as well as <u>Secondary Vocational Education and short Additional programmes</u>.

In case you need to improve your Russian language level the Scholarship will cover a <u>Russian Language Preparatory Course</u> as well, prior to the main study course, usually at the same university or city. The vast majority of programmes in Russia are taught in Russian language.

Russian Government Scholarship fully covers only tuition fees. Accommodation fees and monthly stipend depend on educational level and university. So, decide on possible funding options for accommodation, travel expenses, visa, health insurance, etc.

#### WHO CAN APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP TO STUDY IN RUSSIA?

All candidates with Malaysian citizenship who graduated from a secondary school/ a high school (with total amount of 11 years of study) or a vocational school/a college can apply for a Scholarship to study on a Bachelor degree programme or for Secondary Vocational Education.

To apply for a Master and PhD degree, Residency studies or Additional programmes you should be graduated with a <u>higher education degree</u>. No age restrictions for applicants.


#### HOW TO ENROL?

Step 1. Register on the website and choose a suitable programme and university

Candidates apply for a Scholarship as well as for a main study programme and a Russian language course on the same website (education-in-russia.com) and in the same application form. No need to apply to a university additionally.

First fill in your profile, choose a programme and a university from the list of available ones, and attach your documents as required.

There are over 400 universities across more than 80 Russian regions with a wide range of educational programmes of different levels and in various fields of study. Decide on the education programme and the list of universities offering the chosen course (up to 6 universities listed in order of preference).

# Step 2. Attach your documents and submit your application

### **Required documents:**

- Profile (fill in on the website);
- Your photo;
- Scan copy of your passport (the passport must not expire earlier than 1.5 years from the date of intended entry);
- School or university degree certificate with transcripts (if not completed yet, please provide transcripts of the last year of study);
- Certificates of your other academic, cultural or sport activities and achievements if any;
- Motivation letter or/and a List of published research papers for Residency and PhD programmes candidates.

Please monitor your status and notifications at your personal profile on education-in-russia.com.

#### Step 3. Take the first stage selection test in Malaysia

The selection process for scholarship candidates may include assessment of portfolio and an interview at the Russian Centre for Science and Culture (Russian House in Kuala Lumpur).

- Once your application accepted register for an interview through your personal profile and attend it at the scheduled time.
- Got a number score and a candidate ranking for your country.
- Check your personal profile whether you have qualified for the second stage of the selection process.

## Step 4. The second stage of selection by universities

The second stage of candidates selection is conducted by the universities you choose.

- Check your personal profile regarding any additional tests by universities.
- Receive your test results on the website and contact your university.
- Have all of the necessary paperwork prepared before travelling to Russia.
- Check whether your documents need to be consularized in Malaysia.

## Step 5. Get your student visa and come on over

Student visa is issued at the Consular office of the Russian Embassy in Malaysia. If you get a Scholarship you will receive a status notification and a visa invitation prepared by the Ministry of Education and Science of Russia by e-mail. You need also to check your invitation status at <a href="mailto:russia-edu.ru">russia-edu.ru</a>. Once an invitation received, collect your documents and address to the Consular office.
